Dear All,

It is now April and our Specialty Show Premium List has gone out. We hope everyone can make it to Kalamazoo, Michigan. It should be a fun, exciting four day weekend! Entries for the ANLC Specialty close May 25, 2009. Entries for UKC's Premier shows (Friday-Sunday) close May 15, 2009. Classes at UKC's Premier show with numerical limits, such as agility, obedience, etc close once those limits have been reached. Please don't delay until it is too late.

UKC has announced a new program, emphasizing their "Total Dog" philosophy. Starting June 1, 2009 and running through May 31, 2010, UKC is offering \$25.00 gift certificates to those dogs and their owners who title in each activity where they do not already have titles on that dog. It is called the "UKC Activity Rewards Program". This is open to all dogs competing in UKC including those with "Limited Privilege" numbers. If a dog for example earned, before this time period, a conformation champion title and then earns within the time period a Rally Obedience novice title, the dog earns the gift certificate. If however the dog already had the UAGI Agility title and then earns another UKC agility title, this doesn't count as it is not in a different activity. I also wish to encourage us all to register all of our dogs with UKC. For our breed, besides other registries, registration papers from the Norwegian Lundehund Club of America are also accepted, as stated on the back of UKC's Single Registration Form, which can be found on UKC's website under "registration". I also wish to encourage all breeders to litter register their puppies as well. In "walking the talk", every puppy that we have bred has come with UKC litter registration papers.

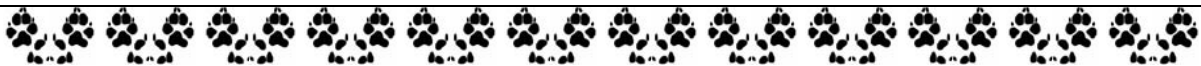

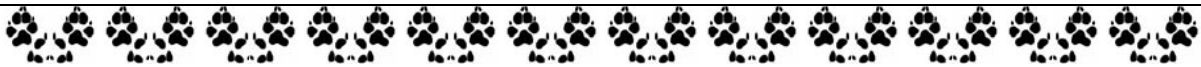

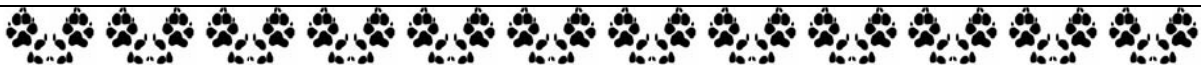
