

THE AMERICAN NORWEGIAN LUNDEHUND CLUB **GUIDELINES FOR THE ANLC VERSATILITY PROGRAM**

The sheer purpose of this ANLC Versatility program is to acknowledge and encourage the achievements of the Norwegian Lundehund and their owners in a variety of established activities. The (VC) Versatility Certificate, or the (VCX) Versatility Certificate Excellent and (VCM) Versatility Certificate Master are given to those members' Lundehunds that have earned the required awards and or titles.

Points are not cumulative in any one group (ie., a UKC Championship earns two (2) points and a UKC Grand Title earns three (3), with a Group Placement earning one (1) point towards the (Miscellaneous) GROUP H: therefore a Champion with a Group Placement earns a total of three(3) points. But a Grand Champion with a Group Placement earns four (4) total points. Points **CANNOT** be awarded more than once for the same item, so, one Group Placement earns one (1) point, additional Group Placements **DO NOT** earn additional points. Again, a CD earns three (3) points; a CDX earns two (2) points, but a UD earns two (2) points towards the (Miscellaneous) Group H. The H Group is: addition to points in a same given area. Or other titles.

Please remember, the key emphasis here is **versatility**, the ability to do a variety of things, not the same ole, same ole over and over.

Only the points for the more difficult title will be awarded within a category. Maximum number of credits is 2 towards a VC and 3 for a VCX and the VCM. Information supplied to the (VP) Versatility Program must include proof of credit, rules of sanctioning organization and an explanation of the activity or sport for additional miscellaneous titles. If a new activity or sport becomes popular, it may be given its own category and moved out of the miscellaneous point Group H.

An application can be submitted for any living Norwegian Lundehund whose owner is a member in good standing of the UKC American Norwegian Lundehund Club. Points may have been earned over more than one calendar year.

The owner must do all of the record keeping for the dog until requirements have been met. Once a dog has earned the necessary points, the owner then sends COPIES of the proof (certificates, score sheets, etc.) and listing of title for requirement earned with a \$5.00 handling fee in the form of a check or money order made payable to ANLC:

Schedule of points for the Versatility Certificate Award

(Effective July 1, 2009)

- A) VERSATILITY CERTIFICATE (VC) – Requires a total of 6 points earned from a minimum of two categories with a minimum of 2 points from each category.
- B) VERSATILITY CERTIFICATE EXCELLENT (VCX)-Requires a total of 9 points earned from a minimum of three categories with a minimum of 2 points from each category.
- C) VERSATILITY CERTIFICATE MASTER (VCM)-Requires a total of 12 points earned from a minimum of four categories with a minimum of 2 points from each category.

Rules relating to specific categories:

Public Service-Therapy dogs can be approved by any sanctioning body, but documentation must include a signed statement that the dog has performed a minimum of ten (10) hours of actual therapy work. The statement must include the name of the organization and the name with address, plus telephone number of the signer.

Temperament Test- Points can be achieved under any of the organizations giving temperament tests. A signed statement with all the information requested under ‘therapy dogs’, with a statement whether the dog passed or fail will be required.

CHIC #: A copy of the dogs’ CHIC certificate will be requested for the points to be a credited.
